



Simple Rules for a Bushwalking Club Walk

1. Be On Time

Arrive early and ready to walk at the stated meeting time.
Let the leader know if you're running late or can't make it.

2. Follow the Leader

Stay behind the walk leader and in front of the tail-end walker (tail end Charlie)..

3. Stay Together

Keep in sight of the person in front.
Wait at intersections or creek crossings.
Let someone know if you need to stop or leave the trail.

4. Be Prepared

Bring enough water, snacks, suitable clothing, hat, sunscreen, and a raincoat.
Wear sturdy walking shoes or boots. Carry a basic first aid kit.

5. Leave No Trace

Take all rubbish home, including fruit peels, crusts, etc.
Respect nature: don't pick plants, feed wildlife, or stray off track.

6. Respect Others

Walk quietly and give space to others.
Help create a friendly and supportive group atmosphere.

7. Use Devices Wisely

Keep phones silent.
Use your camera respectfully (ask before photographing others).

7. Nominate for the walk early

Let the walk leader know you are coming early in the week, and remember there may be a cap on numbers for safety and comfort
